# 1st step: Visa!

## 2nd step: IAEL

→ Through the platform <a href="https://iael.em-lyon.com/IAEL/">https://iael.em-lyon.com/IAEL/</a> :

- Log in with your emlyon email address and the password that you will receive in a few days
- Fill in all the sections and validate each of them until every sections' button is green
- Don't forget to click on the "validate your file" button, at the bottom right
- If you choose an online payment, and don't see the online payment link, log out once and then log in to see the link appear at the bottom right
- Your status will change to "finished" meaning your file is waiting to be treated by the Student Support. Whether it is complete or incomplete, you will receive an email.

# 3rd step: Housing

- <u>Studapart Network</u>: log in with your emlyon's email address or your personal address with the activation code HOUSINGEMLYON. Students who may not have a guarantor can benefit from a guarantee service (<u>with service charge</u>) through the platform!
- <u>Housing Anywhere</u>: this is the international housing platform; you can use it to find housing anywhere in the world. **More info** vip@housinganywhere.com
- <u>Adèle</u>: a student residences network, free of charge with no obligation!
- Le foyer de Reuilly : "le foyer de Reuilly welcomes young professionals, jobseekers, apprentices, who come from Paris, and all around the world.[...] Its constant concern is to offer an increasingly warm and welcoming place with a dynamic team, a variety of activities and care its development, all of which are signs of attention."
- Nativing : A service dedicated to Internationals with a French native being your "native language coach" with a temporary housing period. With service charge.
- Facebook Group "Asso Logement emlyon"

#### **Rent Guarantee services:**

- Garantme: This service can be of great help for internationals who often cannot meet the owner's criteria concerning rent guarantees. With service charge
- <u>SmartGarant:</u> Founded by two former emlyon students, they also offer a service of rent guarantee for students. <u>With service charge.</u> Benefit from a special discount with the promo code: backtoschool
- Visale: This rent guarantee service is offered by the state and based on specific criteria (for example having a valid residence permit). Check out this tutorial!



- Make sure to <u>apply for a visa if necessary</u> (this needs to be done several months in advance)
- Make sure to <u>bring your passport</u> (or ID card for EU citizens)
- Make a copy of your passport, French visa and all other important documents and save them as a PDF document for safety
- Make sure that <u>your current passport is valid</u> for at least six months after your return date
- Bring <u>an original version of your birth</u> <u>certificate</u> and a certified translation in French (with filiation)
- Book a temporary accommodation for your first few nights in Lyon
- Contact your bank to ensure that you can withdraw money in France
- Make sure to <u>have some cash available</u> for your arrival (avoid large amounts for safety)
- Research in advance how to easily access the campus
- Check that your phone works for the first few days once you are in France
- Keep emergency contact information with you
- Bring important <u>medical records</u> (if you have an ongoing medical condition for example) and a copy of your vaccination records
- Have a <u>valid European Health Insurance</u> <u>Card</u> (for European students only)
- > Bring the original of your English tests (if any)
- Bring the original of your diploma and transcripts with you (not a copy)
- > Bring a plug adaptator if necessary

#### From the Gare de Lyon Train station:


It's a 3 minute walk

## **Living Costs?**

### Total expenses in a month: around €1300 (minimum)

- Rent: €700 and more (approximatively)
- Transportation: €342 for 1 year (at student price. Regular pricing: €827.20 for 1 year)
- Food: €300
- Books, photocopies...: €40
- Miscellaneous (insurances, council tax, clothing...): €100
- Mobile Phone: prepaid phone cards start at €5 \*
- Leisure: €100
