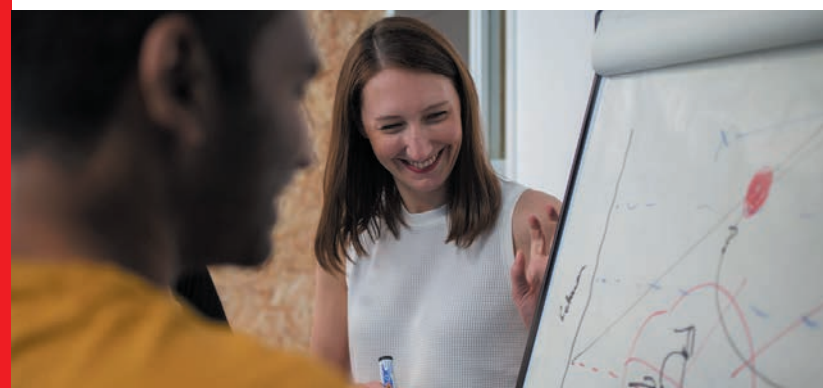

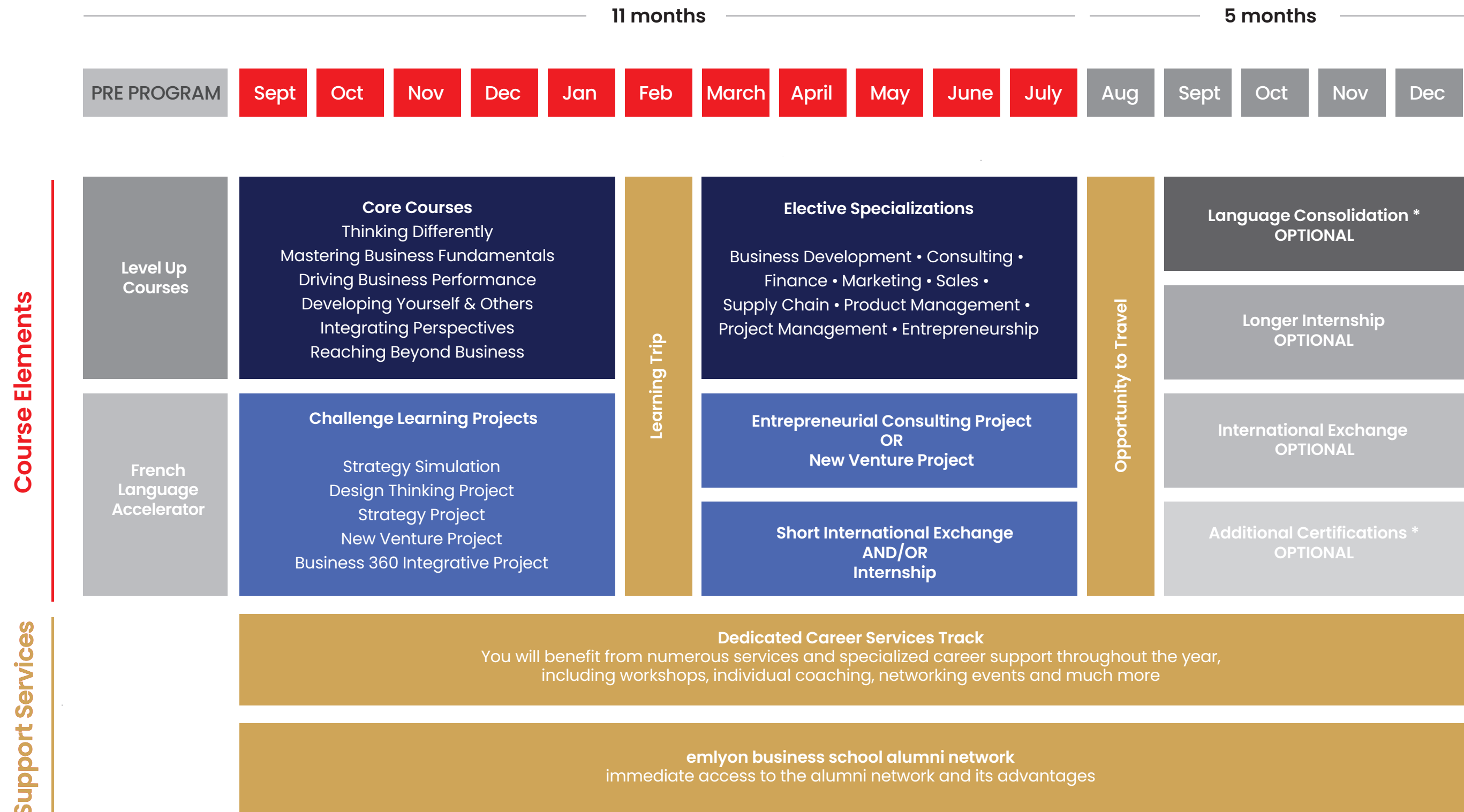

Participants of the International MBA need a tangible way within a real business setting to immediately put academic knowledge into practice and gain real-world experience to complement existing skills. emlyon's **early makers** signature teaching style is the driving force behind the school's pedagogy: demanding standards, experience, experimentation, and an entrepreneurial ethos to boost students' capacity for action. That's why the program incorporates a 6-month Entrepreneurial Leadership Project (ELP). Participants have to choose one of the two following options: entrepreneurial consulting project or new venture project.

Entrepreneurial Consulting Project

An ELP Consulting Project allows you to choose a topic or company in line with your professional goals, drawn from a list of exciting company project briefs. Working in teams and supported by a high-level company sponsor and faculty tutor, you will pitch business solutions. It is also an opportunity to pitch yourself as a future employee, or to leverage your experience in future interviews.

The companies and projects are carefully selected each year and matched to the needs and interests of the class.
